St Mark's uses Showmyhomework to set homework and to post work online for those pupils who are self-isolating or shielding.

Showmyhomework - Key Functions

To do list: when you click on the To do list, you have your homework at a glance. If you tick off completed homework on the right hand-side, the task will disappear from your To do list.

Calendar: we recommend that pupils use the Calendar as this presents tasks in a manageable-looking format, showing at a glance when work is coming due. 


